COVID-19 PERMITTED ORGANIZED SPORTS
GENERAL INFORMATION

All applicants requesting a Department of Parks and Recreation Facility Permit are required to read the [Hawaii Department of Health \(HDOH\) Guidance for Youth Sports, COVID-19 \(Guidance\)](#), and prepare and implement a written COVID-19 plan that is consistent with the HDOH Guidance.

To the extent consistent with the Hawaii Department of Health Guidance for Youth Sports, applicants and participants must also follow applicable guidelines from the [CDC](#) as amended which includes, but is not limited to:

1. Designate a COVID-19 Point of Contact and maintain all records (Guidance, pg. 6-7, 02/10/21).
2. Contact Tracing Plan (Guidance, pg. 2, 02/10/21).
3. Applicant should consider requiring parent/guardian signed acknowledgement of the risks of youth sports participation at this time and agreement to comply with the guidelines put in place by the youth sports organization (Guidance, pg. 2-3, 02/10/21).
4. [Health Screening Checks](#) (Guidance, pg. 3, 02/10/21).
5. Cloth masks should be worn at all times by players, coaches, officials, parents, spectators and volunteers. Cloth masks can be removed only while in the water when participating in water activities (Guidance, pg. 3-4, 02/10/21).

6. Hygiene requirements including hand sanitizing, cleaning and disinfecting equipment (Guidance, pg. 4-5, 02/10/21).
7. Physical Distancing and Modified Layouts (Guidance, pg. 5-6, 02/10/21).
8. There shall be no spectators, fans, or family in the vicinity of the field/court at issue. Only participants, coaches, and/or staff are allowed.
